Adverse weather conditions (lighting, high winds, rain)	Electrocution, structural collapse, exposure	Participants, Instructors, Spectators	4	2	8	Unit to be lowered in case of suspected electrical storm (if storm appears suddenly, all persons to leave area immediately - at least 15 metres away).
